Executive Session: An Executive Session was held beginning at 8:10 p.m. for discussion of testimony regarding student case #2017-2018-5.

Hearing resumed at 8:20 p.m.

Motion: A motion was made by Craig Allen and seconded by Mary Thomas to find Student 2017-2018-5 guilty and to accept the Administration's recommendation. The student:

- Student 2017-2018-5 is expelled from school through the end of the third marking period of 2018.
- Student will be eligible to return to school at the beginning of the fourth marking period subject to compliance with the following conditions:
 - a. Student has been seen and assessed by a professional health care provider and follows the course of any treatment recommended by that provider. Proof of compliance and verification that all conditions/recommendations of the assessment have been fulfilled and that Student does not present a threat to himself or others must be given to the District prior to re-enrollment of Student for the fourth marking period.
 - b. If all conditions are not met, Student is expelled through the end of the 2017-2018 school year.
- Arrangements must be made by Student and his family to pay restitution for the extra security costs amounting to \$408 that was required by the terroristic threats. If this condition has not been met by the end of the third marking period, then Student will be expelled through the end of the school year.
- Student will be excluded from school property during the period of expulsion.
