

8020 DRIVER EDUCATION: Combination of 30 hours of theory in the classroom & 6 hours of in car over the road practice driving with instructor and the option of taking the PA junior driver's license test.

Grade(s): 9-12 Credit(s): 0.25 Weight: 1.0 Summer Course Prerequisite: None

Day(s): classroom would be 5 days of 6 hours per day. Over the road training would take place throughout the summer, as well as school year based on student and instructor availability.

Objectives: To provide students with the basic knowledge, skills and understanding of situational (offensive and defensive) driving and lifelong driving. Description: The course is offered to all grades 9-12. Students will be shown and will practice the I.P.D.E system of driving. Students will learn to Identify, Predict, Decide, and Execute situations involving driving to enable efficient driving habits and awareness. The use of videos, text books, permit testing manuals, guest speakers, online authorities, distraction hikes or observations and various other medians will be used. Expectations: It is the design of the course to have students gain focused awareness of the art and skill of driving. Students will have a better grasp on what it takes to develop offensive and defensive skills over a lifetime. They will develop "action" skills that will enable better planning and decisions while driving.

You must take the theory portion of the program in order to be eligible to take the over the road training. The 30 hour class will be offered once in June (13th,14th,17th,18th,19th). The department of education mandates 30 hours of classroom time in order to be a PDE certified Driver Education program. Once you have started the classroom portion and have received your PA learner's permit, you may be scheduled to start over the road training. Instructors are certified to issue the PA junior driver's license test within the 6th session of the training. After you have completed 30 hours of theory course work and 6 hours of driver training you will be issued a certificate of completion you may present to your insurance company.

- Certificate of completion of a PDE Driver Education program

Must pay \$335 if student takes on-line 30 hour course in order to sign-up for 6 hours over-the-road
