Dear Seniors, Parents and Guardians:

Jersey Shore Area Senior High School Graduation will be held on Saturday, June 6, 2020 adhering to COVID-19 Phase Yellow requirements. On May 11, 2020, the Jersey Shore Area School Board of Directors waived district policies pertaining to graduation and promotion requirements for Jersey Shore Area School District students. These waivers were necessary in accordance with the statewide COVID-19 school shut down issued by Governor Tom Wolf and Secretary Pedro Rivera. Graduation ceremonies for the 2019-20 school year must follow the guidelines set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Education and Department of Health. As you are aware, our area is still operating in Phase Yellow which is anticipated through the next few weeks, impacting graduation.

The 2019-20 Jersey Shore Area Senior High School Graduation Plan, in its entirety, is attached to this email to every senior student. These unprecedented times call for creative solutions to challenging problems. Unfortunately, due to the COVID-19 school closures, we are not able to proceed with graduation ceremonies as they have occurred in the past. However, the 2019-20 Graduation Plan provides an opportunity for our students to realize prestige and recognition by walking across the stage in honor of their achievement as a high school student and graduate of Jersey Shore.
