At a special meeting on April 29, 2020, the Jersey Shore Area School District Board of Directors unanimously (9-0) approved me as the district's next Superintendent. I come to Jersey Shore with Central Office experience at the Milton Area School District and prior experience as a building administrator and classroom teacher. Jersey Shore's mission is to "provide a supportive environment where all members learn, grow and succeed to positively impact the world around them." in the fulfillment of that mission.

I hold a Doctorate in Public Administration from West Chester University, a Master's degree in Education and a Superintendent's Letter of Eligibility from California University of PA, and a Bachelor's degree in History and Spanish Education from Mansfield University.

Our district mission says that all members learn, grow and succeed. This fall, we are making plans to do that in the safest way possible.
