**Board of Education – Disciplinary Hearing**  
**February 10, 2020**

**Hearing:**

Mr. Craig Allen, President, called the Disciplinary Hearing to order at 9:46 p.m.

Testimony: The meeting was turned over to Christopher Kenyon, Hearing Examiner for the Disciplinary Hearing.

Executive Session: An Executive Session was held beginning at 10:10 p.m. for discussion of testimony regarding student case #2019-2020-6.

Hearing resumed at 10:27 p.m.

Motion: A motion was made by Wayne Kinley and seconded by Nancy Petrosky to find Student 2019-2020-2 guilty. The student will:

- be expelled until the end of the third marking period (March 25 barring any snow days).
- be referred to the Student Assistance Program.
- have a drug and alcohol assessment performed by a recognized drug and alcohol counselor.
- be required to comply with the recommendation of the drug and alcohol counselor before being permitted to return to school, if any.
- be required to comply with the recommendations of the drug and alcohol counselor after his return to school and any failure to comply will result in expulsion for the rest of the 2019-2020 school year.
- be excluded from school property during the period of expulsion and shall not participate in school activities during the period of expulsion unless invited back onto school property by the District.
- not be permitted to participate in any school or extra-curricular activities for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.
- attend Jersey Shore Online Learning during the period of expulsion.

The vote was 6-yes and 2-no. Motion carried.

The Disciplinary Hearing was adjourned at 10:28 p.m.
