Permits:


- Parking permits are limited and on a first-come, first-serve basis
- Permit must be displayed in all lots
- Permits must be returned at the end of the year

Application:

- Fully complete online application
- \$20.00 permit application fee
- One vehicle per parking permit application
- \$10 replacement fee

Parking Violations:

- Issued by the Tiadaghton Valley Regional Police Department
- · Loss of parking privilege
- May be towed at owners expense

Student Parking Regulations Jersey Shore High School

The Jersey Shore Area School District provides student transportation to and from school through contracted bussing services. Parking personal vehicles at Jersey Shore Area Senior High School is a privilege for junior and senior students.

Students must accurately complete the Parking Application available through the PowerApp on the iPad. If approved, students will be issued a parking permit. The number on the pass will correspond to the space assigned. There are a limited number of parking spaces available at the high school. Student parking is located in the lower portion of tier 2, all of tier 3, and around the track fence. Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Students must have an approved JSHS parking permit displayed on the rear-view mirror in order to park in these lots.

Students who park without a pass will be ticketed. Accumulation of excessive tickets will result in towing of the owners car at the expense of the owner.

Parking Regulations

The following regulations will be adhered to by all student drivers. Upon signing the contract, I agree to the following:

- The "parking permit/decal" will be displayed on the back of the review mirror at all times.
- Students must back into the parking spaces in tier 2 & 3. Students may pull into track spaces.
- Adhere to all traffic signs and speed limits (15 mph) on school property. Stay in your lane when exiting. Yield to busses.
- Once parked, report directly to the school. Please don't loiter in the lot.
- Student vehicles are not to be used as a locker. Student access to their vehicles is limited to emergency or extenuating circumstances only through the main office only.
- Visitor and Staff spaces are reserved.
- Drivers must be completely stopped before picking up any passengers.
- Students are responsible for reporting updated vehicle information to the main office.



- Students who allow another student or underclassman to use their parking decal for any reason will lose their parking privileges for a minimum of 20 school days.
- Students will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with good citizenship and safety.
- Violations of these regulations and/or reckless /careless driving of any kind may result in disciplinary action, traffic citations, and/or loss of privilege.

First Offense: Permit suspended for twenty (20) school days.

Second Offense: Permit suspended for forty-five (45) school days.

Third Offense: Permit suspended for the remainder of the school year.

 Any act that is a chargeable violation of the PA Vehicle Code (Title 75) will result in immediate revocation of the parking permit by school administration
