## **American Legion Post 36 Scholarship Criteria**

- 1. The applicant must be a graduating senior at Jersey Shore Area High School.
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled in a career, vocational, technical college or a four-year college/university studying in a technical field or in an academic setting. Documentation of such enrollment is required before scholarship awards are paid to the student's account at the applicant's institution.
- 3. Awards are one-time awards and are not renewable. Awards for 2022-2023 are anticipated to be for five recipients and will be \$2,000 each. The number of awards and amounts of awards are not guaranteed and are subject to change at the discretion of the Foundation.
- 4. The primary intent of the scholarship is to acknowledge the applicant's academic achievements, character, and community contributions of the applicant. Financial need of the applicant may be a consideration.
- 5. Student scholarship winners authorize the use of the student's photograph on any form of Foundation communication that identifies the awarding of a student scholarship.
- 6. Write an essay (300 to 500 words) that answers the following questions:

What are your career goals?

Why have you chosen this particular field of study?
