The Marguerite Carl Smith Foundation invites Jersey Shore Area High School seniors and graduates to apply for the Marguerite Carl Smith Scholarship. Recipients will be chosen from applicants who come from the top third of their high school class or who have a current college grade point average of 3.0 scale or better (on a 4.0 scale). It is expected that the applicants will be accepted at, or currently attending an institution of higher learning, and will have submitted the following documents by **March 30**.

- 1. Scholarship Application
- 2. Current Seniors: Official Jersey Shore Area High School transcript with most recent marking period, showing class rank and SAT scores.
- 3. First time College Students: Official college/university transcript.
- 4. Three letters of reference; two of which should come from high school teacher or college teachers, if you are in college.

Consideration will be given first to applicants whose intended or current field of study is teaching, nursing, or other medical fields.

A recipient may re-apply for the scholarship each of three consecutive years provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale) in the major and overall as a full-time student. If the student's educational program exceeds four years, the scholarship committee may consider an exception to the above guideline. *The renewal amount may vary depending on the amount in the scholarship fund*.
