Keystone Testing Days / Spring 2023

Morning Attendance Options

For those **NOT** scheduled for testing you have the option of arriving at the normal start time 8:00 AM or alternate start time 10:00 AM / 11:00 AM. We will follow a delay schedule on testing days. Below are the expectations and procedures we will follow.

- **Testing days:** Students who are testing need to arrive at the NORMAL start time and report to homeroom.
 - May 15 and 16 English Literature (3-Hour Delay Schedule May 15) (2-Hour Delay Schedule May 16)
 - May 17 and 18 Algebra 1 (3-Hour Delay Schedule May 17) (2-Hour Delay Schedule May 18)
 - May 22 and 23 Biology (2-Hour Delay Schedule)
- Students not testing have two options:
 - o Arrive at the normal time for homeroom starting at 8:00 or
 - Arrive at the delay time and report to the gym until released for homeroom
 - 2-Hour Delay Report time is 10:00 AM
 - 3-Hour Delay Report time is 11:00 AM
- Attendance will be taken twice
 - 8:00 AM for testing and to verify who is in the building for both testing and the full day.
 - 10:00 AM / 11:00 AM to determine who arrived at the optional delay start time.
- Students NOT testing who arrive at 8:00 will have two options during testing hours.
 - Option One: At the start of testing report to and stay for the entire testing period in an approved room for a specific purpose supervised by a teacher. An example of this might be Yearbook / working on the Yearbook.
 - Option Two: At the start of testing report to the gym area and stay for the entire testing period. Students will be supervised by the PE teachers and other teachers. ONLY IF THEY ARE FINISHED WITH THE SMARTFUTURES ASSIGNMENTS.
 - ALL Students: Students NOT testing are required to complete the Future Ready PA
 Career Development activities in the SmartFutures Program. **See Assignment
 Expectations.
- Students who arrive at the delay time 10:00 AM / 11:00 AM should expect the following:
 - Arrive no earlier than 9:50 AM / 10:50 AM
 - Report directly to the gym through the pool / gym lobby doors being prepared to display their ID to the security person at the door. (Entrance B)
 - Students will remain in the gym until the conclusion of testing.

• SPECIAL NOTES:

- Buses will run at the NORMAL time ONLY. There will be NO additional bus run for the optional delay arrival times. Students who arrive at the delay times need to provide their own transportation. **Must have a parking permit to park at the school.**
- All students will report to home room for attendance and announcements at the conclusion of testing and when directed to do so.
- Parents of students who are NOT testing who want their children accounted for starting at 8:00 AM need to provide a request in writing to the school for this purpose.
 Be sure to include the student name, grade and homeroom.
- Students who are **NOT** arriving until the delay times (10:00 AM / 11:00 AM) should **NOT** be on school property or outside the school before 9:50 AM / 10:50 AM. When arriving, students are expected to enter the building and report to the gym, quietly and not disturb testing.
