



**Come and get help from Lock Haven University to complete the FAFSA!**

**When: Wednesday, February 7, 2024 from 6:00 – 8:00 PM**

**Where: Jersey Shore Area High School – Second floor - computer lab beside the library (B222)**

**Why complete the FAFSA?** It is the only way to find out if you qualify for “free money” awards and low-cost student loans.

**Who should attend:** Parent(s) AND Student

**Call the guidance office to save a seat: 570-398-7170 ext. 10006**

Best to complete ahead of time: Obtain a Federal ID for both the student and the parent at [www.fsaaid.ed.gov](http://www.fsaaid.ed.gov)

To complete the FAFSA, you need to bring information from several types of documents.

**Personal Documents**

- **Social Security number** - student and parent(s)
- **Driver's license number** and state of issuance (if any)

**Proof of Income** – student and parent(s)

- **Taxable income** from W-2 forms or other records of money earned or received
- **Untaxed income**, including workers' compensation; child support; housing, food and other living allowances; or veteran's benefits, etc.

Use income records from the calendar year that is prior to the year you plan to attend school.

**Tax Documents** – student and parent(s)

- **Federal Income Tax Return** (most recent tax returns - 2022)
- (IRS tax form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) if you were required to file (Note: If you complete your FAFSA online, you have the option of automatically retrieving your income and tax data from the IRS and having it transferred into your FAFSA. The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is the preferred method to complete the FAFSA.)

**Assets** – student and parent(s)

- **Bank statements**
- **Business and investment information**, including business and farm records; stocks, bonds, and other investment records (as applicable)
