- Must be attending a college, trade school, or military.
- Must demonstrate similar values to Courtney Miele: hard working, dedicated, kind-hearted, funny, open-minded, non-judgemental.
- Must have good grades, but not limited to honor roll.
- Must have a love of the outdoors and conservation, a possible interest in the medical field, and believe in and support individual rights.
- Must submit the completed application to the high school guidance office by March
 7, 2025. If you are enrolled in remote learning, you will need to submit the completed application and email it to debbdls@yahoo.com for review.
