#### **HISTORY**

Organized in February 1937, the Williamsport Music Club became an affiliate of the Pennsylvania Federation as well as the National Federation of Music Clubs. Its long life in the Williamsport community is reason enough for pride, but its history holds many highlights of musical accomplishments.

At that first meeting Mrs. Frank Budd, called Madelyn by all who knew her, was named its first president. Her vision was to provide the Club with a strong foundation of purpose. Stated in its original context, the purpose of the organization was to "acquire a broader knowledge of music." Madelyn Budd had a special interest in young people. In the years that followed, her encouragement led to the formation of a Juvenile Music Club, a Junior Music Club, and a Student Musicians Club. The Junior Music Club continued the longest, flourishing under several successive leaders until 1978. Before her death, Madelyn Budd established a fund, now depleted, to provide scholarships to deserving high school seniors.

Each year since 1996 a concentrated and energetic effort has been made to raise money for a new Scholarship Fund. We are delighted to say we have been successful. Because of the efforts of many, we are able to offer a \$1,500 scholarship this year. To honor the memory of Madelyn Budd, the award bears the name THE WILLIAMSPORT MUSIC CLUB / BUDD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.

This Scholarship COMPETITION is open to any LYCOMING COUNTY high school senior who is planning to continue studying or actively participating in music in college.

- Performance material should be selected from classical standard repertoire minimum 8 minutes. If two pieces are performed, they should be contrasting selections.
- The music must be memorized. (Organists are <u>not</u> required to memorize.)
- The applicant is responsible for providing live accompaniment. (NO RECORDED ACCOMPANIMENT IS PERMITTED.)
- Please be aware that the same music should be used for the application, audition, and the GALA performance.
- GALA performance must be from memory.

In all auditions the judges may decline to name a winner if, in their opinion, no entrant meets the high standards of the award.
